

## **BAUS 2025 – Abstract Format Guidelines**

## **Checklist for Abstract Submission**

Please read the checklist carefully and ensure all the requirements have been met. The markers will reserve the right to give nil mark to any abstract that do not meet the stated criteria.

Requirement	Check
Abstract is submitted in English and does not exceed a maximum of <b>250</b> words and with a title that does not exceed a maximum of <b>75</b> words.	
The names of the author(s) and institution(s) only appear where requested and <u>are not</u> included in the text of abstract.	
Named authors are limited to a maximum of <b>10</b> . Any more than 10 authors are added as an 11 <sup>th</sup> entry and named <b>et al.,</b>	
Figures and tables do not exceed more than ${f 1}$ in total.	
References are not cited, unless deemed essential to the abstract and in this case, they are in the form (Smith et al. BJUI 1999; 75: 100-1) within the text.	
The abstract is Calibri 11pt font	
The abstract is in four sections; Introduction; Patients (or Materials) and Methods; Results; Conclusions.	
Abstract submitted by no later than 11:00am (GMT) on 8 January 2025.
