BAUS 2025 – Abstract Format Guidelines

- Abstracts should be submitted in English and must be a maximum of **250** words and titles must be a maximum of **75** words.
- The names of the author(s) and institution(s) should appear only where requested and should not be included in the text of your abstract. **Reviewers have been instructed to give a nil mark to any abstract in which the author or institution is identifiable.**
- Named authors will be limited to a maximum of **10**. If you have more than 10 authors, the 11th author entry should be named **et al.**,
- Figures and tables should number no more than **1** in total. More than **1** supporting documents will not be included during the abstract marking process or included in the BAUS 2024 abstract book.
- In general, references should not be cited but, if they are deemed essential to the abstract, they should be in the form (Smith et al. BJUI 1999; 75: 100-1) within the text.
- The report must use Calibri 11pt font.
- The abstract should be in four sections; **Introduction; Patients (or Materials) and Methods; Results; Conclusions.**
- Avoid detailed descriptions of methods and results, which can be provided during the oral or ePoster presentation.
